Matt. 13:53-58 Nazareth's Second Rejection of Christ

John 6:22-71; 7:1 Peak of Popularity Passes in Galilee

John 19:18-27 6 Events of First 3 Hours on Cross.

Acts 1:14 Last mention of Mary.

1. How does John refer to Mary in his gospel?
2. What response does Mary often have to events in her life?
3. What verse in the gospel of John describes Jesus' childhood?
4. What verse in the gospel of John describes Jesus from 12 to 30 years old?
5. What is probably Jesus' first miracle?
6. How many times in the gospel of John is it stated that Jesus' time had not yet come?

How many times is it stated that Jesus' time had come?
7. When Jesus returned to His home town about a year after He started His ministry, what did His family think of Him?
8. Is it a bad thing if we are so believing in Jesus that people think we are crazy?
9. What kind of things might we do because of our faith in Jesus that would make people think we are crazy?
10. What questions do you have about God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, church, prayer, God's will, events in your life, feelings?
