1. Why (in your own words) is it good to know signs of salvation?
2. What is not a reason to have signs of salvation?
3. What work does God ask you to do that you don't like to do?
4. What work has God given you that you do in your own power, and would like to have God's power?
5. What are various things that keep us from looking and seeing the harvest field of souls that need Jesus?
6. What are the steps necessary before reaping a harvest?
7. Paul says “Jews ask for signs and Greeks search for wisdom but we preach Christ crucified” (1 Cor. 1:22-23a). The Samaritans in this account believed based not on signs but solely on what?
8. Could you set aside two days to be with Jesus reading the Bible? Could you set aside 15-minutes to an hour a day? Will you?
9. If you are saved by Jesus' work on the cross, what sign(s) of salvation do you see in your life?
10. What signs of salvation would you like to see more of in your life?
